INVESTS IN NEW MARKING EQUIPMENT!



HITACHI Finnforest was the first company in Europe to order a new Hitachi RX-S ink-jet printer.

DPI Coding Oy and Hitachi presented the new RX ink-jet printer for the first time in Europe at the Pactec trade fair in Helsinki in 2010.

Finnforest, which is part of the Metsäliitto Group, is one of Europe's largest producers of timber products and has over 3 000 employees.

Plywood sheets withstand tough treatment and are highly resistant to moisture.

Finnforest's wide range of plywood panels is the result of a long Finnish timber tradition stretching back over a 100 years.

The company invested in a new ink-jet printer for marking plywood at its Suolahti factory outside Jyväskylä. Finnforest chose to replace its marking equipment with a new Hitachi RX-S. The new machine had to be reliable and

cost effective, and require only minimal, straight forward maintenance.

Mika Häkkinen at Finnforest's Suolahti plant tells us that the printer works exactly as it should and meets all the requirements.

We should perhaps add that it stands in an extremely dusty environment but works perfectly nevertheless.
